COPY OF A DESPATCH FROM HIS GRACE THE DUKE OF NEWCASTLE TO GOVERNOR GORE
BROWNE, C.B.Downing Street,
20th February, 1861.NEW ZEALAND.

With reference to my Despatch, No. 93, of the 16th of December last, informing you that Her Majesty's Government had decided on sending a second Regiment of Infantry from India to New Zealand, I have now to acquaint you that intelligence has been received from India that the authorities there were making the necessary arrangements for at once despatching the 70th Regiment to that Colony.
