"	No. 2	Appropriation - -	An Act to appropriate the Revenue of the Province of Hawke's Bay, for the year commencing the 1st day of January, 1860, and ending the 31st day of December, 1860 (£45,444 16s. 7d.).	Obsolete.
1861	III—No. 1	Harbour Reserves Act -	An Act to enable the Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay to manage and administer by sale or lease certain Public Reserves.	Assented to, 27th July, 1861.
"	No. 2	Educational Reserves Act -	An Act to enable the Superintendent to manage and administer certain Reserves by granting Leases thereof.	Assented to 27th July, 1861.
"	No. 3	Provincial Council Enlargement.	An Act to enlarge the Provincial Council, and to alter the Electoral Districts of the Province of Hawke's Bay.	Assented to, 27th July, 1861.
"	No. 4	Sheep and Scab Act -	An Act to repeal the various Acts relating to Sheep and the disease in Sheep called Scab, and to make other provisions in behalf of the same.	Returned for amendment.
"	No. 5	Appropriation - - -	An Act to appropriate the Revenue of the Province of Hawke's Bay, for the year commencing the 1st day of January, 1861, and ending the 31st day of December, 1861 (£34,684 3s.).	Obsolete.
