"	No. 2	Immigration and British Agent.	An Ordinance for promoting Immigration to the Province of Southland, and appointing Agents in Great Britain for that and other purposes.	Returned for amendment, 4th December, 1861.
"	No. 3	Southland Loan	- An Ordinance to authorise certain sums of money to be raised by sale of Debentures for public purposes, in the Province of Southland. (£10,000.)	Disallowed, 4th December, 1861.
"	No. 4	Diseased Cattle	- An Ordinance to prohibit the introduction of Cattle into the Province of Southland from Localities where Disease prevails, and to prevent the spreading of Disease amongst the Cattle in the Province.	Disallowed, 4th December, 1861. Provided for by No. 23, 1861, of General Assembly.
"	No. 5	Appropriation	- An Ordinance to appropriate the Revenue of the Province of Southland for the period of nine months, from and after the 1st day of April, 1861. (£12,116 5s. 7d. and £2,189 6s. 5.)	Assented to, 4th December, 1861.

NOTE.—These Schedules having been compiled from the records in the Colonial Secretary's Office, do not in any way refer to Bills which may have lapsed in the Provincial Councils, or been disallowed by the Superintendent. They terminate with the year 1861, even though a particular Provincial Council may at that period have been in the midst of a Session. This has been done for the sake of uniformity.
