

RETURN

OF

ALL NATIVES WHO HAVE SURRENDERED UNDER HIS EXCELLENCY'S PROCLAMATION OF AMNESTY.

[*Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated 10th December, 1864.*]

"That there be laid on the table of this House a Return shewing the names, tribes, and usual residences of all Natives (if any) who may have accepted the terms of His Excellency's Proclamation of Amnesty, up to the day limited for its duration, the 10th December instant.

"Also, a Return of all tracts (if any) of land, giving the district, estimated area, geographical boundaries, as far as can be done, which may have been ceded by any Natives under the above Proclamation, to the satisfaction of His Excellency and General Sir D. Cameron, K.C.B.

"Also, a copy of any Proclamation or Declaration giving the extent of forfeiture of land intended to be made by the Governor, which may have been issued in pursuance of the instructions given him by the Right Hon. Mr. Cardwell, in his Despatch of the 26th April, 1863."
