That there be laid upon the Table of this House—"A Return showing the Number of Canoes belonging to Natives, together with the Number of their Crews and the Quantity and Species of Native-grown Produce (as nearly as can be ascertained) that arrived in the harbours of Auckland and Onehunga between the 1st day of January, 1850, and the 31st day of January, 1859, together with the remarks of the Commissioner and Inspector of Police which accompanied the Quarterly Returns on this subject, supplied to the Government by those officers."
