

# ENDOWMENTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF NATIVE SUBJECTS OF HER MAJESTY, ETC.—(continued.)

THIS Schedule does not contain Grants for Churches, Hospitals, Burial Grounds, Markets, &c., which are declared to be for the benefit of the public, or the inhabitants of a particular place, though some of these, as in the case of Hospitals, Lunatic Asylums, &c., are as much for the benefit of the Natives as Europeans. It includes only Grants in which the Aboriginal Natives of New Zealand are expressly alluded to; either by the phrases "the Natives of New Zealand," or "persons of both races," or similar expressions; and Grants for Mission Stations and missionary objects, which are obviously Grants for the benefit of the Natives almost exclusively, although they are not expressly mentioned therein. Grants in trust for "religious and charitable purposes" are not included.
