New Plymouth, 13th July, 1866. SIR,-I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your circular letter No. 20, of the 14th instant, and enclose herewith a Return of the local taxation in this Province.

The only assessed rate shown in this Return, is the road rate imposed on all lands within the Town of New Plymouth. This rate is on the assessed value of the land without improvements, and the

valuation may on the whole be taken to represent fairly the present marketable value.

The rating of rural lands was necessarily discontinued during the years in which they could not be occupied, and was resumed towards the end of last year; but no rural rates became due during the I have, &c., vear 1865.
