(a) Mr. Carnochan, First Keeper at Dog Island Lighthouse, was engaged in England by the Provincial Government of Otago, at a salary of £250 a year, which has been continued by the Marine Board.

The whole amount of salaries, including Light-keepers, shows £23,575, but from that sum Warden Johnson's salary should be deducted, which leaves the absolute expenditure under that head £3,200 per annum.
