a Mr. Kilfoyle held the appointment of Messenger from May 9, 1855, making a total of eleven years. The Provincial Treasurer has not drawn any salary since his appointment.

The clerk, Mr. Mogenie, receives 2½ per cent. commission (from the funds of the trusts) on the amount of rents collected, being somewhere about £70 per annum.

Two extra Clerks are employed during session, at 15s. per diem, and two extra Messengers, at 7s. 6d. The session lasts about three months.

b In addition to the gross period of eighteen years service as above, there was four years service under the New Zealand Company, employed in survey of harbours and coast, and exploration of Wellington, Taranaki, Nelson and West Coast of Middle Island.

c In addition to the period of eleven years service as above, there were ten years service in the R. E. Department, as clerk and draughtsman, employed chiefly in relation to the formation of the Pensioners' Settlements.

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
