Company and Canterbury Association July, 1848; was absent from the Colony on sick leave 3 months in 1859, and 3 months in 1865. Before coming to New Zealand, he was 2 years in the Civil Service in London.

^f Was 3 years Assistant Surveyor to General Government and 3 years to the New Zealand Company.

^g Was 4 years Assistant Surveyor to the General Government and New Zealand Company.

^h The field allowance to Surveyors is £120 per annum, for which they provide tents, boats, carts, horses, tools, cooking utensils, &c.; when necessary they keep riding horses for which they receive an additional £50 as forage money. Survey labourers ration themselves, receiving 6s. to 8s. per day. Instruments and drawing materials provided by P. Govt.
