^b Joined the Public Service in Nov., 1851, as clerk to Col. Wakefield, N. Z. Co.'s agent in Wellington. Removed in 1845 to head office in London, in charge of the Land and Emig. Department. Transferred in 1850 to charge of Emig. Dept. of Canterbury Association, and continued in that capacity until Association closed in 1852. Proceeded, in 1854, twice to Melbourne for the Prov. Govt., to select emigrants, and finally entered its service, as clerk to Supt., in 1856.
^c Mr. Halcombe has retired since this return was made, and has been succeeded by W. Hickson, Esq.
^d Has been a public servant 20 years. Was appointed principal clerk to Col. Wakefield, agent of N. Z. Co., in 1840; principal clerk of Land Office under Company, in 1845, which appointments were held until Company surrendered their Charter in 1850, when H. E. Sir George Grey, appointed him Chief Clerk in Crown Lands Office, Wellington, which office he retained during the Commissionerships of Messrs. Bell and Fox. Appointed Commissioner of N. Z. Co.'s Land Claims in 1859, and lost Land Order Commissionership in 1862.
^e Previously to joining the Provincial Government Survey Department, Mr. Stewart had been employed for a considerable time in the Native Lands Purchase Department.
^f Mr. John Knowles joined the Survey Department, as Cadet, in 1857.
