UNISSUED DEBENTURES.

(Return to an Order of the House of Representatives of the 24th September, 1868.)

Also, for copies of any Memoranda or other Papers showing the arrangements under which advances were made to any of the Provinces to cover their overdrafts at the Bank of New Zealand which existed at the time of the passing of 'The Public Debts Act, 1867.'"
