

be as the pool of Siloam. When you go away from here let all the old prejudices and old feuds be washed away. You have brought peace and good here ; you have caused this house to receive its present name ; you have Siloamed it. When we separate do not let this be a long separation ; let the Pakeha and the Maori come to the Aomarama, and let us hope for better times for the future."

Mr. Fox then wound up the meeting with words of *Aroha*, and shook hands with the Chiefs. Then he went back to Wanganui.
