Extracts from the Journals of the House of Representatives, Thursday, the 31st day of August, 1871.

ORDERED, That the petition of John London and Frederick Alexander Whitaker be referred to a Select Committee, to inquire into and report on the allegations contained therein, in accordance with recommendation from Private Petitions Committee. The Committee to consist of the Hon. Mr. Hall, Mr. Carrington, Mr. Haughton, Mr. J. Shephard, Mr. Eyes, Mr. Thomson, Mr. Karslake, Mr. Johnston, and the mover, with power to call for persons and papers. Three to form a quorum. To report in fourteen days.
