AMOUNT OF REVENUE COLLECTED

UNDER THE GOLD DUTY ACTS.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated the 22nd August, 1871.

That there be laid on the Table—"A Return of the amount of Revenue collected under 'The Gold Duty Act, 1858,' 'The Gold Duty Act, 1870,' 'The Mining Companies Acts 1865 and 1869,' 'The Gold Fields Act, 1866,' and the several Gold Fields Acts passed by this House since 1866, and any Regulations made in conformity with the said Acts, for the Year ending 30th June, 1871. The Return to show in detail the amount collected in each Province and County under the following heads:—Miner's Rights, Business Licenses, Rents and Fees for Water Races, Sluices, &c., Gold Mining Leases, Rents and Royalties, Registration Fees, Miscellaneous Receipts, Fees and Fines Wardens' Courts, Gold Duty."
