*Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated 29th July, 1874,*

“That there be laid upon the Table a Return of all Moneys paid to each Provincial Government during the Year ending 30th June, 1874, for Rent of Premises occupied for the purposes of the Supreme, District, and Resident Magistrates’ Courts, Registration of Land Titles, Customs, Post Office, Telegraph, and other Departments of the Colonial Government.”—(*Mr. Curtis.*)
