Examination Board during the financial year ending 30th June, 1875:—

#### DECEMBER 1874 EXAMINATION.

Thirty candidates presented themselves for the Junior, and 12 for the Senior Examination. these, 26 passed the Junior Examination, and 10 the Senior.
