Memo. by Commissioner of Crown Lands.—There is in some cases but a small advance on present rates: this applies to the back country of the Timaru district and the neighbourhood of the Lakes about Mount Cook. In other cases the new rates are three times or five times the present rates: this applies to the Plains and the runs on the eastern seaboard. All previous legislation regulating the rents to be paid for runs in Canterbury have been based on an uniform acreage rate without regard to locality or relative value, and hence the very wide difference between the amount of advance in one case and in another.
