EXCHANGE OF LAND

(PAPERS RELATIVE TO AN).

Presented to both Houses of the General Assembly in pursuance of Section 148 of "The Land Act, 1877.'

EXCHANGE of LAND in the PROVINCIAL DISTRICT OF CANTERBURY.

JAMES PRENDERGAST, Administrator of the Government.

WHEREAS by the one hundred and forty-eighth section of "The Land Act, 1877," power is given to the Governor to exchange any land set apart as a reserve for other land of equal value as he may

think fit, and to make a Crown grant thereof accordingly:

Now, therefore, I, James Prendergast, Chief Justice of the Colony of New Zealand, and Administrator of the Government thereof, in exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the said Act, do hereby declare that the land mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be exchanged for the land mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

Description and Purpose of Reserve intended to be Exchanged.

Description of Land to be Obtained in Exchange therefor.

Section No. 1429 (in red) in the Ashburton District, Provincial District of Canterbury. For a gravel-pit. Described in the Provincial Government Gazette, dated 18th February, 1874, as containing 12 acres, and found on survey to contain 14 acres 3 roods 20 perches. Of which it is proposed to exchange 13 acres and 36 perches. Bounded—Northward by Sections Nos. 6811 and 16855, 1104 and 448 links respectively; Eastward by the Longbeach Road, 1012 links; Southward by a line at right angles to the eastern boundary; and Westward by Section No. 6812.

All that parcel of land in the Hinds Survey District, Provincial District of Canterbury, containing 13 acres and 36 perches, more or less, being part of Section No. 8402. Bounded—Northward by Reserve No. 1429 (in red); Eastward by the Longbeach Road, 964 links; Southward by a road-line; and Westward by Section No. 6812.
