11. No payments other than the fees, which are perquisites of the lecturers and examiners, are

made to the college by the students.

12. The College Council expends £100 per annum in scholarships, and two (Science) scholarships, each of £100 per annum, entitled the Sinclair and Gillies Scholarships, have been endowed by Mr. Justice Gillies.

13. An audited statement of the accounts is hereunto annexed.
