EXPENDITURE UPON MAINTENANCE OF EACH DEPARTMENT OF
THE COLONIAL GOVERNMENT FOR YEARS 1860, 1865, 1870, 1875,
1880, 1885, 1886, AND 1887
(RETURN SHOWING).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated the 5th May, 1887.

Ordered, "That a return be laid before this House showing the expenditure in the years 1860, 1865, 1870, 1875, 1880, 1885, and 1886 on account of salary and allowances to the Governor and maintenance of Government Houses, salaries of Cabinet Ministers, travelling and other expenses of such Ministers, maintaining the ministerial residences, the Legislative Council, the House of Representatives, and each department of the Colonial Government of New Zealand; being a reprint of Return B.—16, 1886, with particulars for the financial year ending the 31st March, 1887, added. Such return also to show the gross totals for each year named."—(Mr. Barron.)

RETURN showing the EXPENDITURE in the Years 1860, 1865, 1870, 1875, 1880, 1885, 1886, and 1887, on account of Salary and Allowances to the Governor and Maintenance of Government Houses, Salaries of Cabinet Ministers, Travelling and other Expenses of such Ministers, maintaining the Ministerial Residences, the Legislative Council, the House of Representatives, and each Department of the Colonial Government of New Zealand, chargeable on the Ordinary Revenue of the Colony.
