Ordered, "That a return be laid before this House showing the expenditure in the years 1860, 1865, 1870, 1875, 1880, 1885, and 1886 on account of salary and allowances to the Governor and maintenance of Government Houses, salaries of Cabinet Ministers, travelling and other expenses of such Ministers, maintaining the ministerial residences, the Legislative Council, the House of Representatives, and each department of the Colonial Government of New Zealand; being a reprint of Return B.-16, 1886, with particulars for the financial year ending the 31st March, 1887, added. Such return also to show the gross totals for each year named."—(Mr. Barron.)
