SPECIAL SETTLEMENT EXPENDITURE IN AUCKLAND

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, No. 10, 1887.

Ordered, "That there be laid on the table a statement showing the items of expenditure in connection with the formation of special settlements within the Provincial District of Auckland, giving the names of public officers or others who have certified to the correctness of the several items under the following headings: (1.) Cost of survey, specifying the locality, and whether conducted by the departmental officers. (2.) Amount paid for houses, clearings, and fencing of land respectively. (3.) Remuneration and travelling expenses paid to Stewards of Village Settlements, with the names of the recipients, and specifying any payments made to or claimed by Mr. J. Lundon. (4.) Miscellaneous expenses, specifying charges for advertising, provisions, freight, passages, public meetings, and other expenditure not included under the foregoing headings."—(Mr. Sutter.)
