Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, No. 10, 1887.

Cost of survey, specifying the locality, and whether conducted by the departmental officers. (2.) Amount paid for houses, clearings, and fencing of land respectively. (3.) Remuneration and travelling expenses paid to Stewards of Village Settlements, with the names of the recipients, and specifying any payments made to or claimed by Mr. J. Lundon. (4.) Miscellaneous expenses, specifying charges for advertising, provisions, freight, passages, public meetings, and other expenditure not included under the foregoing headings."—(Mr. Sutter.)
