Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated 2nd November, 1887.

Ordered, "That a return be laid before this House of all sums of money expended in making roads between Wanganui and the North Island Trunk Railway; also for snagging the Wanganui River, and building steamers, boats, punts, &c.; and from what fund the money has been obtained."—(Mr. MONK.)
