The usual table (H) showing the number of pupils under instruction in the several subjects of the primary course is given below. Twenty-three pupils in the District High School at Greymouth are included in the total, but for some reason or other have been omitted in the analysis. The table seems to show that, as in former years, there are some children who receive no instruction in any subject except reading, and others that learn no arithmetic. Wanganui, Nelson, Grey, and Southland are the only districts to which this remark applies. There are still 11,000 girls that do not learn needlework. The number of
