## EDUCATION: UNIVERSITY OF OTAGO.

[In Continuation of E.-6, Sess. II., 1891.]

Presented to both Houses of the General Assembly by Command of His Excellency.

The Chancellor of the University of Otago to His Excellency the Governor.

University of Otago, Dunedin, 10th May, 1892. In compliance with the provisions of "The Otago University Ordinance, 1869," I have the honour to forward the following report of the proceedings of this University for the year ending the 31st day of March, 1892:-

The usual courses of lectures, as laid down in the calendar, have been delivered in the various branches of study taken up by the students attending the University, in arts, law, medicine, and mining.

The degrees obtained by the students at the November examinations are as follows:—

Master of Arts of the University of New Zealand—W. Burnside, with second-class honours in physical science; A. Campbell, with third-class honours in mental science; Catherine Ferguson, with third-class honours in chemistry; J. Mackenzie, with second-class honours in Latin and English; W. D. Milne; Thomas D. Pearce, with first-class honours in Latin and English; C. F. Salmond, with first-class honours in mental science; A. Stenhouse, with second-class honours in zoology; J. G. Stuart, with first-class honours in political science; Marion S. White, with first-class honours in mental science.

The holder of the Scott scholarship is A. H. Adams.

During the past year two vacancies have occurred on the Council owing to the death of the Hon. James Fulton, M.L.C., and the resignation of Mr. John Roberts, C.M.G. The first vacancy was filled by the Government nominating Sir Robert Stout, K.C.M.G. The second vacancy occurred shortly after the passing into law of the new Act of Parliament altering the constitution of the Council, and according to the provisions of the Act the graduates of the University met and elected Mr. David White, M.A., as their representative on the Council. The new Act provides for th nomination by the Crown of six of the twelve members, the graduates elect four, and the Professorial Board two; there are some further provisions, which will be found in the text of the Act.

The tenure of office of the Chancellor and the Vice-Chancellor having expired, the Council re-

appointed, for the fifth time, the Rev. Donald McNaughton Stuart, D.D., as Chancellor, and, also

for the fifth time, His Honour Mr. Justice Williams, as Vice-Chancellor.

During the past year the Rev. A. R. Fitchett gave the classical instruction, acting for Professor Sale, who received leave of absence for the session; Dr. Barnett lectured on surgery, as *locum tenens* for Dr. H. W. Maunsell. Dr. Maunsell has recently resigned the lectureship, and Dr. William Brown has been appointed as his successor. Mr. W. Butler-Williams, B.A., received the appointment of lecturer on the German language.

The Council have during the past year spent a considerable sum in completing the equipment of the Mining School. They have also had a long correspondence with the Minister of Mines, and at his desire have modified the arrangements so as to meet the requirements of all classes of students. The soundness of the instruction given at the school is well shown by the positions now held by the students who have gone through the course of study prescribed for the associateship.

The Council have great pleasure in noticing, from the monthly class returns made by the Pro-

fessors and Lecturers, that the lectures in the various courses have been duly delivered, and that the attendance of the students at the classes is regular.
