NAVAL AND MILITARY LAND CLAIMS

(RETURN OF) LODGED SINCE 25TH SEPTEMBER, 1891, AND NOT SUBSTANTIATED.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated 21st September, 1892.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing the names and regiments or commissions of all claimants under the Naval and Military Settlers' and Volunteers' Land Act whose claims have been lodged since the 25th September, 1891, and have not been substantiated; also, briefly, the reasons for their rejection."—(Mr. BUICK.)
