| 373. Adam, Private Samuel ... | H.M. 69th Regiment, Armed Constabulary, and Militia | £ 30 | Rejected, as there is no proof that applicant retired with intention of settling in New Zealand. Service in Armed Constabulary and Militia does not entitle to land. |
| 374. Baker, Horace R. ... | Volunteer Band ... | 30 | Has already received scrip for Imperial service before 1863. |
| 375. Bourke, Ulick ... | Carlyle Rifle Volunteers... | 30 | Already received land as a Military Settler, Taranaki. |
| 376. Bushford, T. H. ... | Waikato Militia ... | 30 | Militia service not entitled. |
| 377. Carroll, Private James ... | Patea Rifles, Militia, &c. | 30 | No record of service as Military Settler Ranger, and only two months' service in Patea Rifles. Militia service does not count. |
| 378. Coffey, Captain Martin ... | Opunake Rifle Volunteers | 30 | Already compensated for Volunteer service. |
| 379. Collart, Private Robert ... | No. 6 Company Military Settlers | 30 | Received grant of 51 acres for service as Military Settler. |
| 380. Conway, Private Patrick ... | Rifle Volunteers ... | 30 | Has already been compensated for Imperial service. |
| 381. Cowper, Serjeant James ... | Patea Militia and Carlyle Volunteers | 30 | Already received land as Military Settler. |
| 382. Dunn, Bugler John ... | Wanganui Rifles ... | 30 | Has received scrip for £30 for Imperial service. |
| 383. Dyer, Private George ... | Wanganui Militia and Kai Iwi Cavalry | 30 | Has only one year's service as Volunteer: Act requires five years. |
| 384. Gayne, Serjeant-Major William | H.M. 99th Regiment ... | 40 | Was not discharged till 1873. Served in New Zealand. |
| 385. Green, Private W. J. ... | Inglewood Rangers ... | 30 | No proof of five years' continuous efficient service as Volunteer. |
| 386. Grey, Private William S. ... | Taranaki Volunteers, Militia | 30 | Failed to prove five years' continuous efficient Volunteer service. |
| 387. Johnson, Serjeant John ... | Taranaki Cavalry Volunteers | 30 | Has already received compensation for services, first war. |
| 388. Johnston, Captain Coslett ... | Hawera Rifle Volunteers | 30 | Already received land as Military Settler. |
| 389. Judd, John ... | Corps unknown ... | 30 | No claim or particulars of service furnished. Notice sent. |
| 390. Jury, Private Richard, sen. | Taranaki Militia and Volunteers | 30 | Has received land as substitute. |
| 391. Kelly, Private James ... | Royal Artillery ... | 30 | Has already received land as Military Settler. |
| 392. Kelly, Private Edward ... | H.M. 57th Regiment ... | 30 | Has received land as Military Settler. |
| 393. Kirkby, Lieutenant J. T. V. | H.M. 20th Regiment ... | 200 | Did not leave service for the purpose of settling in New Zealand. Left the army in 1859; arrived in New Zealand in 1864. Does not apply for colonial service. |
| 394. McCoy, Private John ... | No. 2 Company Volunteers | 30 | Already received land for Imperial service. |
| 395. McLdouri, Private Daniel ... | Wairoa Rifle Volunteers | 30 | Has already been compensated as Military Settler. |
| 396. McSweeney, Sergeant Daniel | H.M. 57th Regiment ... | 40 | Horse Guards advise this man deserted at Auckland, April, 1867. |
| 397. Mulligan, Private Richard | H.M. 65th Regiment ... | 30 | Discharged with character "indifferent." |
| 398. Nathan, Private William ... | Carlyle Rifle Volunteers | 30 | Can only prove six months' service. Act requires five years. |
| 399. Nicoll, Private James ... | Taranaki Cavalry Mounted Volunteers | 30 | Has not proved five years' continuous efficient Volunteer service. |
| 400. O'Brien, Private James ... | Armed Constabulary and Taranaki Bush Rangers | 30 | Has already received land as a Military Settler. |
| 401. Rassmann, Private Charles | Carlyle Rifles and Patea Militia | 30 | Ditto. |
| 402. Richards, William ... | Ambulance Corps ... | 30 | Has received scrip to the value of £15. |
| 403. Ryan, Private George ... | Taranaki Militia ... | 30 | Militia service not recognised. |
| 404. Steer, Private John ... | Taranaki Militia ... | 30 | Militia service not recognised. Has already received land as Military Settler. |
| 405. Weir, Private James ... | H.M. 68th Regiment ... | 30 | Claim not received before sending in discharge, which was not till April, 1893. |
