524. Baillie, Private William ...	H.M. Royal Dragoons ...	30	Did not retire from Her Majesty's service until 1875, three years too late according to the provisions of the Acts.
525. Blake, Sergeant Patrick ...	No. 7 Company Timaru Rifle Volunteers	30	Volunteer service in Canterbury not within scope of the Acts.
526. Booth, Corporal James ...	Porirua Militia ...	30	Militia service not admitted under the Acts. No provision for loss incurred during the wars.
527. Clarkson, John ...	Mauku Rifle Volunteers...	30	Has not proved five years' continuous efficient Volunteer service.
