At the First and Second Standards about 8 per cent. of those who were examined failed, and this result of examination by the head teachers agrees well with the result of examination by Inspectors in these standards in 1893.

The annual reports received by the several Education Boards from their Inspectors are printed in a separate paper (E 1B)

Table H shows the number of pupils under instruction in each separate subject. It thus indicates the limits of the primary school course. At the same time it shows (when compared with the other tables) that five-sixths of the girls are taught needlework, and it shows that nineteen-twentieths of the pupils learn drawing
