Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 5th July, 1895.

Ordered, "That a Return be laid upon the table showing—(1) The number of ordinary working-days; (2) the number of statutory holidays; (3) the number of hours of enforced idleness; and (4) the average number of hours worked per week of all railway employés at the Railway Workshops, Hillside, near Dunedin, during the last three financial years."—(Mr. EARNSHAW.)
