Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return as to the State (or Experimental) Farm, near Waverley, setting out—(1) the area; (2) the value of the land with improvements at time of the State Farm being started; (3) the amount expended since in (a) buildings, (b) fencing, (c) cultivating, including labour, (d) stock, and (e) other purposes; (4) the uses to which the land has been applied; (5) the number of persons employed throughout, and the (a) maximum, (b) minimum, number; rates of salary or wages paid to each class; (6) the number of stock now on the farm, and for what purpose; and (7) the returns (if any)."—(Mr. G. HUTCHISON.)
