## "THE UNIVERSITY ENDOWMENT ACT, 1868."

The income arising from reserves made under this Act is applicable to purposes of higher education, at the direction of the General Assembly. The account now stands as follows: From reserves in Canterbury, £1,342–13s. 4d.; in Westland, £214–12s. 6d.; in Taranaki, £1,989–0s. 3d.

## CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATIONS.

The annual examinations for admission to or promotion in the Civil Service were held in January, simultaneously with the examination of candidates for teachers' certificates. For the junior examination there were 446 candidates, of whom 298 qualified for mention in the *Gazette*, by obtaining the minimum of one-third of the possible marks. For the senior examination there were 101 candidates, and 56 passes. Fuller details are given in the report upon the examinations (E.-1a.).
