OLD-AGE PENSIONS.

RETURN SHOWING NUMBER OF MAORI AND HALF-CASTE CLAIMANTS AND PENSIONERS.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated 4th August, 1899.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The number of Maoris and half-castes of both sexes who have applied for old-age pensions up to 30th June, 1899; (2) the number of pension-certificates issued to Maoris and half-castes of both sexes up to same date."—(Mr. HERBES.)
