# PUBLIC SERVICE SUPERANNUATION BOARD.

(THIRTY-THIRD ANNUAL REPORT OF THE), WITH ACCOUNTS, FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDED 31st MARCH, 1941.

Presented to both Houses of the General Assembly pursuant to the Provisions of the Public Service Superannuation Act, 1927.

# REPORT.

THE Board has the honour to submit its report upon the transactions in connection with the Public Service Superannuation Fund.

Owing to the exigencies of war conditions, the report this year is confined to the following accounts, statements, and tables.

Contributors.—The number of new contributors who joined the scheme during the year, and other particulars, are contained in the following table:—.

Investment of the Fund.—Including £28,471 invested on Stipendiary Magistrates' account, the total investments of the fund amount to £3,136,552.

The average rate of interest earned for the financial year was £4 4s. 9d. per cent., an increase of 3s. 5d. per cent. as compared with the previous year.
