In addition to the special sinking funds mentioned above, special provision exists for the repayment of that portion of the debt funded by agreement with the Imperial Government. Particulars were published in B.-1 [Pt. III] for the year ended 31st March, 1941, and previous years. Details have not changed since 1932. It was estimated that this portion of the debt would under the original agreement with the Imperial Government.

Section 6 of the Hutt Road Act, 1939, provides that the Wellington City Council shall be kept indemnified out of the Main Highways Account from all liability in respect of loans specified in the First Schedule of the Act totalling £113, 975 12s. 11d.
