Mr. Hamilton, Mr. Holland, Miss Howard, Mr. McKeen, Mr. Polson, Mr. Sheat, and the Mover."—(Hon. Mr. O'BRIEN.)

THURSDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF JULY, 1946

Ordered, "That the Apprentices Amendment Bill be referred to the Labour Bills Committee."—(Hon. Mr. O'BRIEN.)

TUESDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF JULY, 1946

Ordered, "That the Factories Bill be referred to the Labour Bills Committee."—(Hon. Mr. O'BRIEN.)

FRIDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1946

Ordered, "That the name of Mr. Sheat be discharged from the Labour Bills Committee and that of Mr. W. Sullivan substituted therefor."—(Hon. Mr. O'BRIEN.)

THURSDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1946

Ordered, "That the Shops and Offices Amendment Bill be referred to the Labour Bills Committee."—(Hon. Mr. O'BRIEN.)
