ORDERS OF REFERENCE

Extracts from the Journals of the House of Representatives

THURSDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF JUNE, 1946

Ordered, "That a Select Committee be appointed, consisting of ten members, to consider all matters pertaining to agricultural and pastoral industries and stock which may be referred to it, with power to confer and sit together with any similar Committee which may be appointed by the Legislative Council, and to agree to a joint or separate report: the Committee to consist of Mr. Cullen, Mr. Gordon, Mr. Gillespie, Mr. Herron, Mr. Holyoake, Mr. Langstone, Mr. McCombs, Mr. Walls, Mr. Williams, and the Mover."—(Hon. Mr. ROBERTS.)

FRIDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF JULY, 1946

Ordered, "That the Stock-remedies Amendment Bill be referred to the Agricultural and Pastoral Committee."—(Hon. Mr. SKINNER, for the Hon. Mr. ROBERTS.)

FRIDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF JULY, 1946

Ordered, "That the Stock-foods Bill be referred to the Agricultural and Pastoral Committee."—(Hon. Mr. ROBERTS.)
