EMPLOYEES, DUNEDIN RAILWAY GOODS-SHEDS.

(ADULTS AND YOUTHS DURING 1897, 1898, AND 1899.)

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 3rd July, 1900.

Ordered, "That there be laid before the House a Return showing—(1) The average number of adults employed in the railway goods-sheds, Dunedin, during the years 1897, 1898, and 1899; (2) the number of youths under twenty employed in the same sheds during the same years, and the wages paid them."—(MR. MILLAR.)

Number of Men employed.—1897: 90. 1898: 108. 1899: 100.

Number of Youths under Twenty, and Rate of Pay.—1897: Number, 3; rate of pay per day, 2s. 6d. to 5s. 1898: Number, 8; rate of pay per day, 2s. 6d. to 3s. 6d. 1899: Number, 7; rate of pay per day, 2s. 6d. to 4s.
