*Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 18th September, 1901.*

*Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing the total cost to the colony of the stud animals recently imported from Britain by the Department of Agriculture; and also giving the price paid for each animal, the pedigree of each animal, and the name and address of the breeder or the former owner of each."—(Mr. MASSEY.)*

(2.) Price of each animal:—

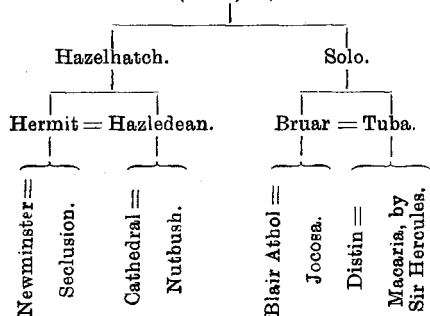
(a.) *Horses*.—Thoroughbreds: Singlestick II., £350; Tyranny, £200; Serapion, £300; Malachi, £200; Amasis, £150; Lupin, £225. Shires: Danger Signal and Hertfordshire Boy, presented by Lord Rothschild.

(b.) *Cattle*.—Shorthorn bulls: Red Lord XXVII., £52 10s.; Tugela, £105; Clarence Duke, £43 1s.; Imperial Yeoman, £73 10s.; Captain Middleton, £52 10s.; Plato, £36 15s. Shorthorn cows: Musical, £42; Delight, £45. Shorthorn heifers: Highway Lass, £31 10s.; Magic, £31 10s. Shorthorn bull: Langford Wallace, £70. Ayrshire bulls: Holdfast of Nethercraig, £50; Earl of Drumdow, £50.

Shorthorn bull "Salisbury" died on voyage; cost of purchase was £52 10s. The costs were covered by insurance, so will be refunded.

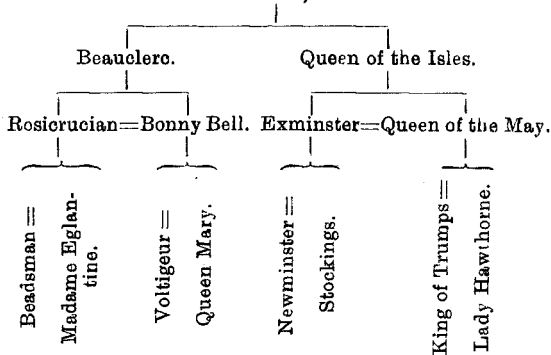

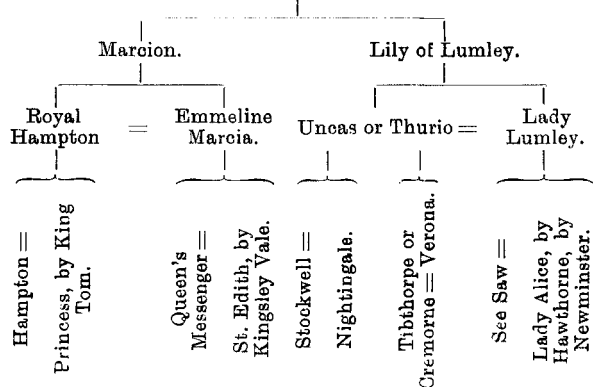

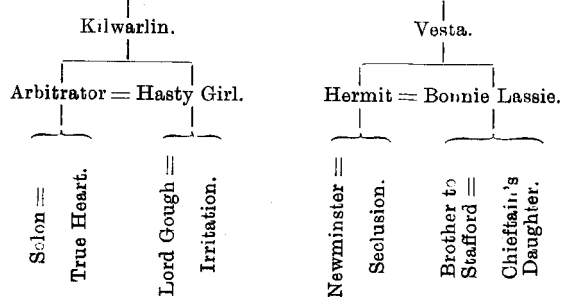

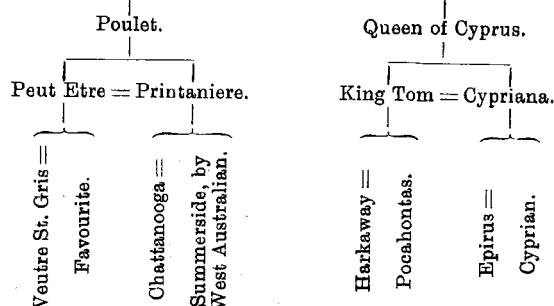

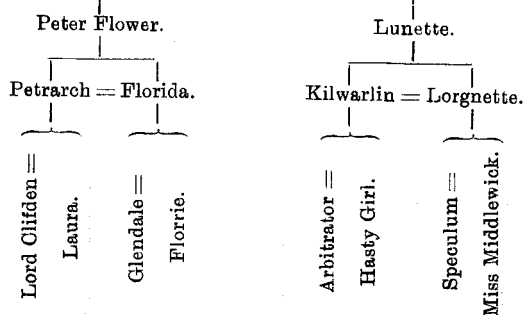

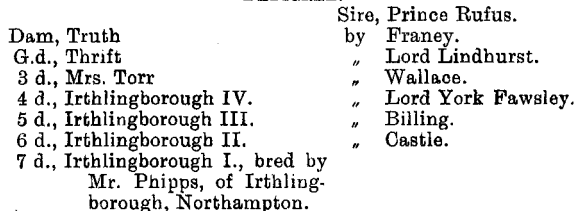

"Orange Blossom XIIIL" has now (13th March, 1901) calved about ten weeks, and is giving 33lb. to 35lb. of milk daily. The sire "Red Lord" was awarded first prize at the Liverpool Show, 1898, and his sire, "Oxford Marquis," on first and special at E. Somerset Show, second at Frome, and third at Somerset County Show.

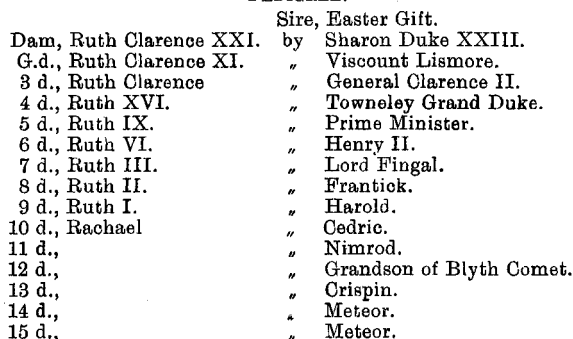

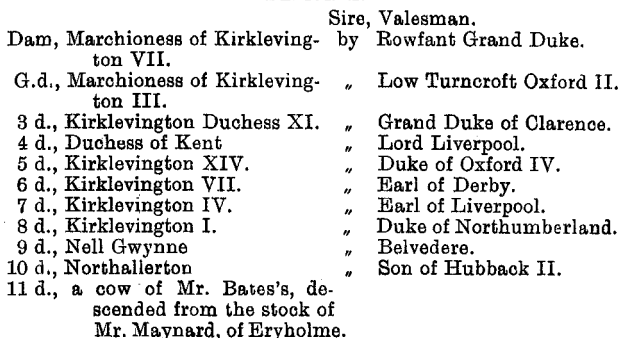
