

PHYSICAL DRILL.—The Board has not yet made any regulations under section 4 of "The Physical Drill in Public and Native Schools Act, 1901." In all the Board Schools a fair amount of instruction in drill and physical exercises has always been given, and in the larger schools the boys have dumb-bell exercises in addition to the military drill, and the girls wand or club drill. It has been considered unnecessary to insist on the small schools (of from two to ten children of all ages) adopting any system.
