ASHBURTON ELECTORATE

(ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR RAILED INTO THE) DURING THE YEARS ENDING 30TH JUNE, 1903, AND
30TH JUNE, 1904.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 19th August, 1904.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The quantities of alcoholic liquor railed to places within the Ashburton electorate during the twelve months ending the 30th June, 1903; and (2) the quantities of alcoholic liquor railed to the same places during the twelve months ending the 30th June, 1904: the return to show either the separate quantities or the totals."—(Mr. McLACHLAN.)
