(See observation on section 233 <i>et seq.</i> The power of the Governor to cancel or suspend an Imperial certificate must be carefully considered. Unless the Supreme Court is a Colonial Court of Admiralty or Vice-Admiralty Court, this section is <i>ultra vires</i> . No observation, but unnecessary. This section is <i>ultra vires</i> unless limited to local certificates. See last observation and <i>cf.</i> section 478 (6) of the Imperial Act. This is <i>ultra vires</i> as to such cases which fall within section 475. See my observations in my general memorandum.
