EDUCATION: ANNUAL EXAMINATIONS.

[In continuation of E.—1A, 1905.]

Presented to both Houses of the General Assembly by Command of His Excellency.

The INSPECTOR-GENERAL of SCHOOLS to the Hon. the MINISTER OF EDUCATION.

SIR,— Education Department, Wellington, 31st July, 1906.

I have the honour to report upon the annual examinations for teachers' certificates for Junior National Scholarships, for junior free places in secondary schools, district high schools, and technical schools, for senior free places in secondary schools and district high schools, and for admission to or promotion in the Civil Service. The examinations were held between the 12th and the 21st days of December, 1905, and between the 5th and the 17th days of January, 1906, at the thirteen towns which are the seats of Education Boards, and also at Alexandra, Aratapu, Arrowtown, Ashburton, Balclutha, Dannevirke, Gisborne, Gore, Hamilton, Hawera, Lawrence, Masterton, Oamaru, Ohaeawai, Opotiki, Otaki, Pahiatua, Palmerston North, Rangiora, Reefton, Riverton, Stratford, Tapanui, Tauranga, Thames, Westport, and Whangarei.

The total number of candidates that entered was 3,318, of whom 316 were absent from examination. The numbers that actually sat for the several examinations were as follows: For the Junior National Scholarship and Junior Free Place Examination, 790; for the Civil Service Junior Examination, 1,305; for the Civil Service Senior Examination, 141; for certificate examinations, 749. The number, 141, given for the Senior Examination includes 17 who are also included in the number, 1,305, given for the Junior Examination.

The Junior National Scholarship Examination was used by all of the Education Boards except two for awarding their junior scholarships, and by Victoria College for awarding the Queen's Scholarships.

The Civil Service Junior Examination was used as the examination for senior free places in secondary schools and district high schools, and also as the First Examination of Pupil-teachers. It has also been adopted by nearly all the Education Boards as the test for their senior scholarships.

The expenses of the examinations amounted to £2,796 19s. 2d., and the fees paid by candidates to £1,613 9s. Printing and clerical work are not included in the account of expenses. The results of the Junior National Scholarship Examination were made known on the 19th January, those of the Civil Service Junior Examination on the 22nd January, those of the Civil Service Senior Examination on the 22nd February, those of the examination for the Education Board's Senior Scholarships and for Senior Free Places on the 23rd January, and those of the teachers' examinations on the 23rd February.

The total number of candidates that sat for the Junior National Scholarship and Junior Free Place Examination was 790, of whom 395 passed the examination, and 114 others satisfied the examination requirements for Junior Free Places, though they did not reach Scholarship standard. The number of candidates that passed in the several education districts were as follows: Auckland, 199; Taranaki, 17; Wanganui, 9; Wellington, 68; Hawke's Bay, 45; Marlborough, 8; Nelson, 17; Grey, 3; Westland, 2; North Canterbury, 26; South Canterbury, 8; Otago, 60; Southland, 33. The highest percentages of marks gained in the several papers were as follows: English, 86; arithmetic, 100; geography, 89; general paper, 95; drawing, 89. The highest percentage gained by any one candidate on the whole examination was 83.

Of the 1,423 candidates for the Civil Service Junior Examination, 773 were seeking appointment in the public service, and 360 passed the examination, 249 of them with credit. Of the successful candidates, those that passed with credit, and such of the remainder as were not over sixteen years of age on the 1st December, 1905, have satisfied the requirements of clause 7 of the Regulations for the holding of senior free places in secondary schools and district high schools. There were 506 candidates for senior free places only, of whom 342 passed the examination.

Of the 141 Civil Service Senior candidates 82 came up to complete examinations in which they had already been partially successful. In all 39 passed the whole examination, one of them with distinction, and there were 87 whose work in certain subjects of the examination was accepted by the Department.

The numbers of candidates that entered for different stages of the teachers' certificate examination, with their status at the time of entry, are shown in the subjoined table.

Of the whole number of 843 candidates 208 have passed—29 for Class C, 164 for Class D, and 15 for Class E—229 have obtained partial pass, 45 for Class C and 184 for Class D; there are 62 whose work in separate subjects of the Class C examination has been accepted by the Department; and 250 candidates, besides 94 absentees, have failed to improve their status.

Appended to this report are lists of the examiners and of the successful and partially successful candidates. The examination papers have been printed separately.
