Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 29th August, 1906.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The population of each of the boroughs of South Canterbury—namely, Timaru, Waimate, Temuka, and Geraldine; (2) the suburban population of each of the said boroughs within a radius of three miles from the Post-office; and (3) the total population, including both urban and suburban, in each case."—(Hon. Sir W. J. STEWARD.)
