SICK AND FUNERAL FUNDS.

The contributions and entrance-fees paid to Sick and Funeral Funds in 1905 amounted to £72,461, and in 1906 to £77,441; dividing these amounts by the mean number of members, the averages are £1 9s. 2d. and £1 9s. 8d. respectively, as against £1 9s. 4d. for 1904.

The interest and rent received by the lodges and central bodies amounted to £39,238 in 1905 and to £43,279 in 1906, equal to 15s. 10d. and 16s. 7d. respectively per member, as compared with

15s. 6d. for 1904.

The amount of sickness benefit paid was £48,260 in 1905 and £52,903 in 1906, equal to £5 19s. 1d. and £5 14s. 4d. respectively per member sick, and averages of 19s. 5d. and £1 0s. 3d. per member, as against £5 7s. 11d. and £1 1s. respectively for 1904. Viewing the amounts paid in relation to the weeks of sickness the average benefit per week is found to be 14s. 3d. in 1905 and 14s. 2d. in 1906, as compared with 14s. 6d. in 1904.

The funeral benefit paid amounted to £10,311 in 1905 and £9,496 in 1906; these amounts

are equal to 4s. 2d. and 3s. 8d. respectively per member, as compared with 4s. 4d. for 1904.

The total worth of the Sick and Funeral Funds at the beginning of 1905 of 501 lodges was £831,889, and at the end of the year £886,531. At the beginning of 1906 the worth for 500 lodges was £886,819, and £946,281 at the end of 1906. The balance of gain for each year was £54,642, or £1 2s. per member in 1905, and £59,462 or £1 2s. 9d. in 1906, as compared with

The total income from investments, less depreciation, credited to the Sick and Funeral Funds for 1905 amounted to £39,238, which is found to yield an average rate of £4.67 per cent. (say, £4 13s. 5d.), as against £4 10s. 5d. in 1904.
