(c.) Fencing;

(d.) Water-service;

(e.) Extra cleaning where temporary buildings are occupied, as, for instance, during the construction of a school, or occupation of hired rooms in cases where the school is too small.

(f.) The Board subsidizes to the utmost of its means the efforts of School Committees to

effect permanent improvements.

The scale of payment quoted on attached sheet is smaller than in some other districts, but the Wellington Board makes to a larger extent than any other Board special grants where the special needs of the school render such assistance advisable.
