OAMARU HARBOUR BOARD LOAN

(PARTICULARS RELATIVE TO THE).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 14th September, 1910.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return with respect to the Oamaru Harbour Board loan, showing—(1) The name of the receiver; (2) the period he has been acting; (3) the amount paid to bondholders; (4) the amount charged for commission; and (5) the amount of solicitors' costs."—(Mr. E. H. TAYLOR.)

OAMARU HARBOUR BOARD LOAN.—Return showing (1) the Name of the Receiver; (2) the Period he has been acting; (3) the Amount paid to Bondholders; (4) the Amount charged for Commission; and (5) the Amount of Solicitors' Costs.

- (1.) The Trustees and Executors' Agency Company, of Dunedin.
- (2.) This company has been acting as receiver since 1894.
- (3.) The amount paid to bondholders since that time is £6,000.
- (4.) The amount charged for commission by the receiver is £4,938 8s. 9d.
- (5.) The receiver's solicitor's costs have amounted to £496 5s. 9d.

These figures are up to the end of December, 1909.
