ORIGINAL CROWN TENANTS UNDER LEASE IN PERPETUITY

(PARTICULARS RELATIVE TO).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 15th August, 1912.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The number of original Crown tenants under the 999-years leases who are to-day in occupation of their holdings; (2) the total area of such holdings; (3) the unimproved (total) value of such holdings; and (4) the total area held under the above tenure."—(Mr. WILFORD.)

RETURN SHOWING, AT THE 15TH AUGUST, 1912, THE NUMBER OF ORIGINAL CROWN TENANTS UNDER THE LEASE-IN-PERPETUITY TENURE WHO WERE IN OCCUPATION OF THEIR HOLDINGS; THE TOTAL AREA OF SUCH HOLDINGS; THE TOTAL UNIMPROVED VALUE OF SUCH HOLDINGS AT DATE OF SELECTION; AND THE TOTAL AREA OF CROWN LAND HELD UNDER THE LEASE-IN-PERPETUITY TENURE AT THAT DATE.
